

Day 2: Walking In Your Power

Yesterday we talked about **Waking Up In Your Purpose!** We discuss the plight of would be king, King David. We talked about how David spent time preparing for his promised position as King. David had to **wake up in his purpose** and we talked about how, if you are going to **get to your last level** then, you are going to have to **wake up in your purpose!**

We also had an exercise where we asked you to close your eyes and look back over your life for those times when you felt like you were in your element and serving others. We then had you to move that calling from your head to your heart. And for homework, I invited you to embrace your purpose mentally, emotionally and spiritually. Because without doing that you can't move to the next step of Walking In Your Power!

Because after you wake up in your purpose then what? What do you do next? Once you've embraced your purpose then what should be your next move?

I'm glad you asked!

Today we are going to talk about **Walking In Your Power!** What does that mean? **Walk In Your Power?** It means that you not only just embrace your purpose but I that you take it to heart and your actions prove that. It becomes a calling. Your reason for being. You look for opportunities to use your purpose to serve others. You see even as king, King David did realize that he had a huge responsibility to serve his people as their King.

Point: Are you ready to serve humanity with your purpose?

Because if you are not ready to serve humanity then you don't truly understand the reason for your purpose.

Dr. Myles Monroe said that "Just as the fruit is not for the tree, neither is your purpose for you. Your purpose HAS TO serve others, in some way, shape or form."

If you truly are **Waking Up In Your Purpose**, then if you look closely you will see someone who needs to be served. I don't care if you love crunching numbers, people need accountants don't they? People need well-manicured lawns. People need visit natural parks and you want future generations to being able to see endangered species, don't you? Whatever your purpose is somewhere in it there is a human element.

Say this with me, I have someone to serve!

Now this time say it like you mean it! I HAVE SOMEONE TO SERVE!

There is someone waiting for you to show up they are waiting for your business, your skill set, your story, your cookbook, your play, your movie, your example! Someone is waiting for you!

Say this with me, Someone is waiting for me!

Say it again!. SOMEONE IS WAITING ON ME!

Now for a present-day example of someone Walking In Their Power!

If you have not already seen **The Black Panther** you need to go and see it, like today! Now I'm not going to give away any spoilers but I am going to talk to you about the main character. Prince T'Chilla was introduced during Captain America Civil War. He assumed the role of The Black Panther after his father was killed in that movie.

When his solo movie came out there was no origin story. He wasn't bitten by so radioactive insect. He wasn't blasted with Gama Radiation. He did come from some distant planet. He didn't have to figure out who he was. He was already the Prince and now he would become King. No one spent time trying to convince him of who he was. That had been engrained in him since birth.

He never questioned who he was. And that's what I want us to take away from the story. He never doubted that he should be King. The real question was what kind of King will you be?

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Without that level of accountability, you will look at your purpose as an afterthought. It will not carry the proper weight needed to make it a priority. We have to see our purpose as something that someone so desperately needs. That should get us to move **BEYOND** ourselves to the mode of truly being a blessing to others.

Walking In Your Power means that you have settled the issue of your Purpose and that it is a done deal. There is no more questioning why you are here. Just like King T'Chilla never questioned who he was, neither should you. The next thing is to step up to the plate and do what you were made for. You have fully embraced your reason for being and now you are ready to get to work. Anyone or anything that would seek to disrupt or destroy your purpose will soon find out that they picked the wrong one to mess with. Not because you are fighting for yourself but you are fighting for those to whom you were sent to serve.

I remember riding my youngest son around while I was putting on my Summit and while I was up to my eyeballs in responsibility this 10-year-old boy said, "Dad, I'm proud of you." You could have spread me on a piece of toast. Because his encouragement melted me inside. But it also helped me to understand that someone was watching. I thought to myself, "If I quite, what message does that send to him?" No, it's not easy. At times it is hard! But it's always worth it.

So not only was I serving the attendees but I was setting a precedent for my children to follow. And you should too. One of the most powerful lines from The Black Panther was from T'Chilla's father, when he said, "A parent has felled if they don't prepare their children for their death."

When we truly **Wake Up To Our Purpose** and **Walk In Our Power**, then we set a standard for those coming after us to do the same. When they see us being relentless in our purpose it gives them permission to do the same.

"Our deepest fear is not that we are inadequate. Our deepest fear is that we are powerful beyond measure. It is our light, not our darkness that most frightens us.'
